DEFINITIONS

Satellite/Cable Viewing: Viewing in homes able to receive broadcasts from at least one channel other than ITV, BBC1, BBC2, CH4, RTE via dish, antenna or cable.

Share of total viewing: The percentage of viewing time accounted for by each channel within satellite and cable homes.

Others: Viewing to broadcasts from other non-terrestrial channels.
